Activities for children working in groups.

- **6. How have uniforms changed over the years?** (You will need to ask older people, research in the library or on the internet. Examples could be scouts, guides, police and others you named above)
- **7. Draw or make a collage of uniforms. Find examples** in newspapers, sports and other magazines, Warwickshire Focus, clothes catalogues, career leaflets, library books, on the internet e.g. (OWL website pictures on www.oneworldlink.org.uk > Education Pages > Resources)
- 8. Take a picture of yourself in your uniform or sports gear.
