

BO OWL RELIEF COMMITTEE REPORT

Saturday 7 March 1992

In an Executive Meeting held on Monday 2nd March 1992, members were informed that the sum of £500.00 (Five Hundred Pounds sterling) was sent by Bankers Draft from Leamington Spa (England) to Bo One World Link. The money, as members were further informed, was to enable the Bo Owl help in the relief of the displaced people as a result of the rebel incursions into Sierra Leone....

It was finally agreed that the money be used to buy household equipment like buckets, plates, spoons, hurricane lamps, etc. to be given to displaced people who had gone back to their villages.... Four villages were selected - two in Bo District (Mano Yorgbor and Limba) and two in Pujehun District (Serabu and Kpeiima).
