

Letter dated 27th April 1993 from David Ngombu, Bo Teachers College, to Myf Hodkin, 17 Albert Street, Leamington Spa

...Happy to write and inform you that the materials that were shipped have started arriving. The first items that were received were those for the hospital and the second-hand clothings and shoes. Immediately these things arrived, the executive of the One World Link (OWL), Bo Committee, met and decided what to do with the materials. The drugs were handed over to the hospital committee, and the second-hand materials to the Relief Committee. The Relief Committee immediately met and decided to distribute these materials. The materials were distributed to displaced school-going children at Gondama refugee Camp - about 8 miles from Bo town. The Christian Brothers based in Bo are running the school and also supplying the refugees with food, clothing and other materials, so we had to use the school list for distribution of the materials. Pictures were taken on this occasion which will be sent together with a detailed report.

With regards the books, we have sorted them out according to schools but we have not distributed them since the schools are yet on Easter vacation. This will be done when the schools open....
