

Letter dated August 1993 from David Ngombu to Myf Hodkin

[He had gone to Segbwema with his mother to attend the funerals of three of her brothers who had died in the Refugee Camp there. He had also tried to see Jenny Gibson but she was too busy.]

Myf, I have sent the report about the distribution of the second-hand materials that you people sent for the displaced people at the Gondoma Refugee Camp- 7 miles from Bo. The materials arrived at the time when the displaced people (mainly children) needed them most. As could be seen in some of the pictures the situation with the displaced people is very pathetic and they need urgent national and international attention. We would be much obliged if you could contact other NGO's for continued help. If you don't mind you can even send us their address and we will endeavour to make the contact...

I am writing this letter in the Reference Section of the Bo Town Library which is linked with that in Leamington Spa. On my right I can see pictures of the main street in Leamington Spa, the staff of the library and some sections in the library. The pictures are so nice.
