

**Letter dated 9 September 1993 from David Ngombu to Myf Hodkin**

[Refers to recent letter regarding the distribution of the second-hand materials and requests acknowledgement that it has been received.]

As was pointed out in the report, the situation with the displaced people at the Gondama Camp is pathetic. A member of the One World Link from your end who visited the camp must have given a vivid report to you people.... In the same report, I requested further help from our friends in Leamington Spa as the condition of our displaced people is serious and needs urgent attentions. For now our government is engaged with the rebel war which is presently affecting the south-eastern part of the country. About two weeks ago rebels attacked a group of Red Cross workers in the Kenema District, Eastern Region, and killed 4 workers. The civilians who had returned to that area fled to the neighbouring towns like Kenema, Tongo Field, Segbwema, etc....
