

## Lesson Plan 10-1

### Clothes and Materials

**Age group: Years...Key Stage 1 and 2**

**Aims:**

- a) To enable children to start thinking about clothes and materials used in both Communities and suggest what may be interesting to find out about them.
  
- b) To help children research the materials used to make clothes
  
- c) To give the opportunity to investigate which countries make the clothes both in here and in Bo

**Resources:**

General African clothes, Photos from OWL website, DVD or Video (Reel Lives) to show people of Bo. Some English non uniform clothes need to be available. Suggestion : Each child could bring 3 items for example.

For each child Worksheet 10-1 a **Key stage 1 children** unable to write could look at their own/ other clothes and have the recording done by teacher or helper.

**Teacher Guidelines:** a Topic could be introduced with teacher led discussion. What would be interesting to find out about clothes both here and in Bo.  
(Materials? Design? Uniforms? Effects of weather here and in Bo on choice of clothing? Where do clothes get made? What are they made of ? etc.)
