Second Speaker:

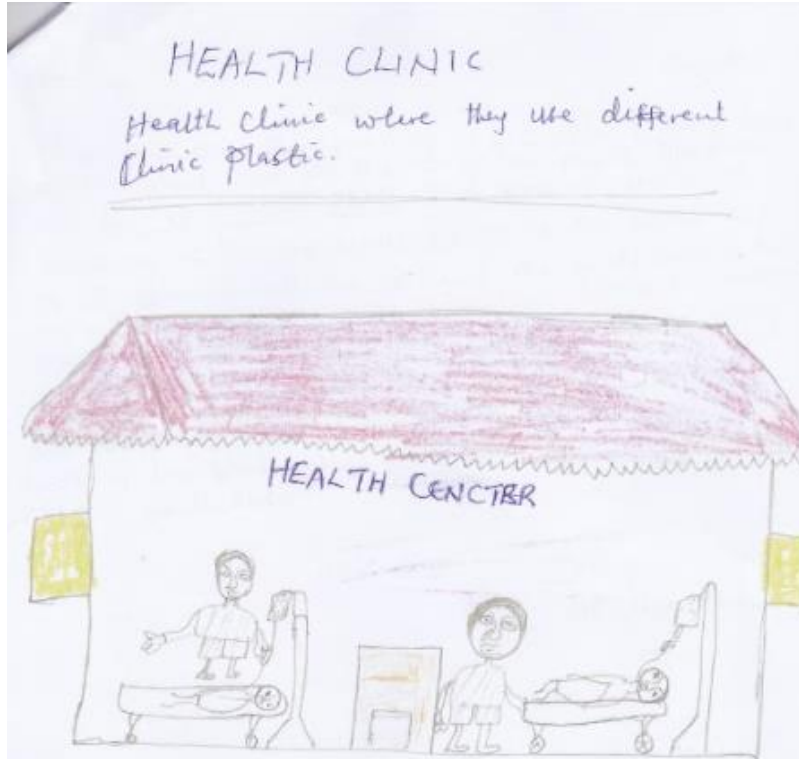
What is wrong with you Pa Koroma? What is your problem?

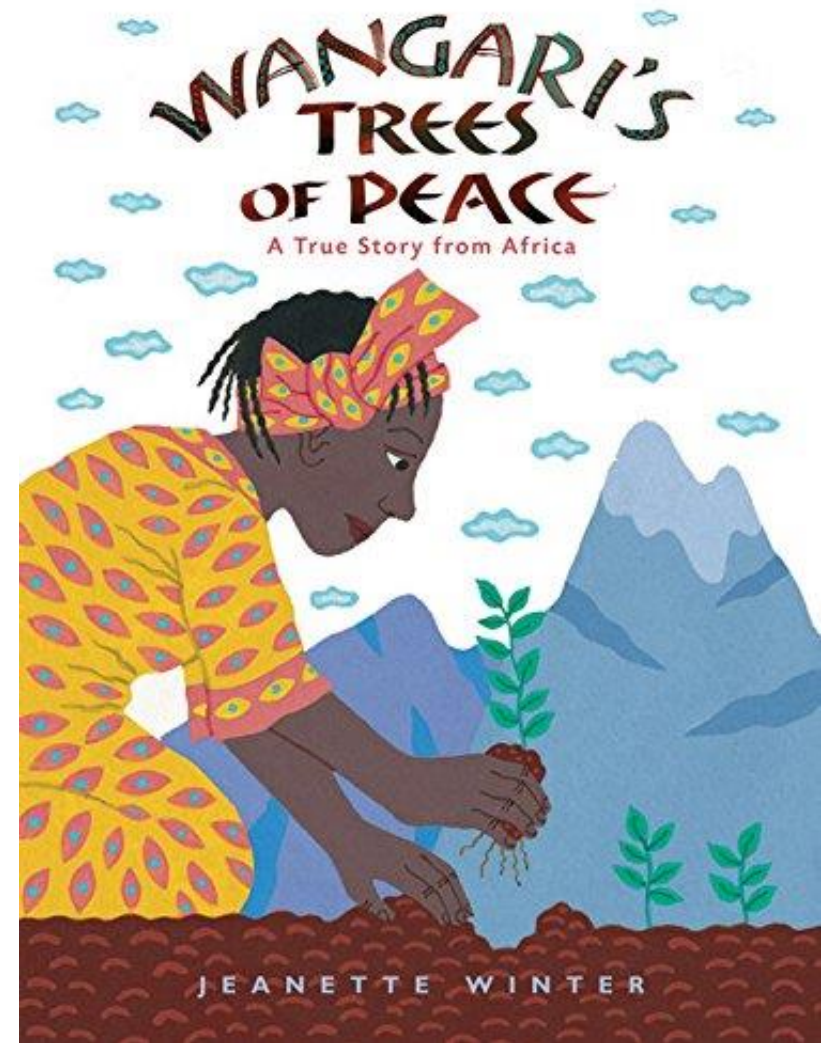
